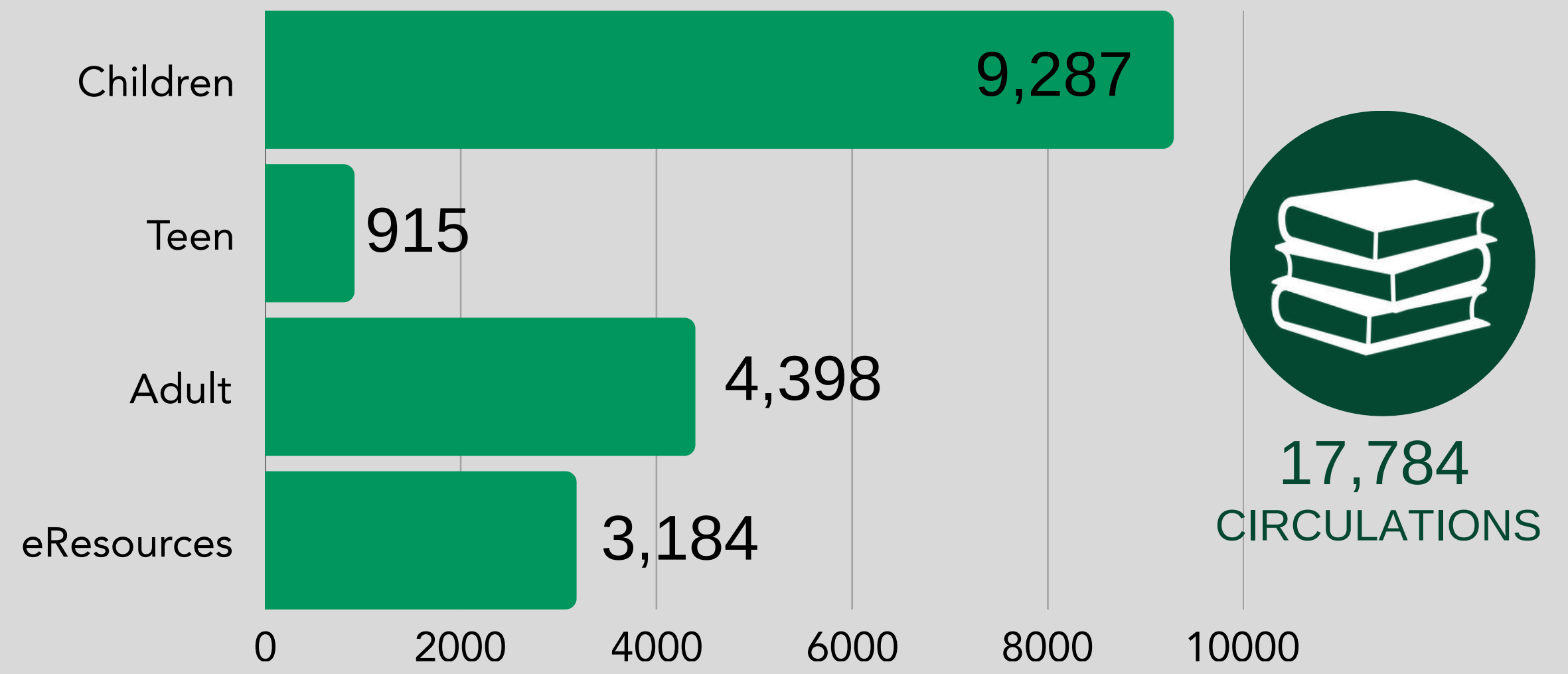


TOP: Children display their collectible trading cards earned for every 20 minutes read

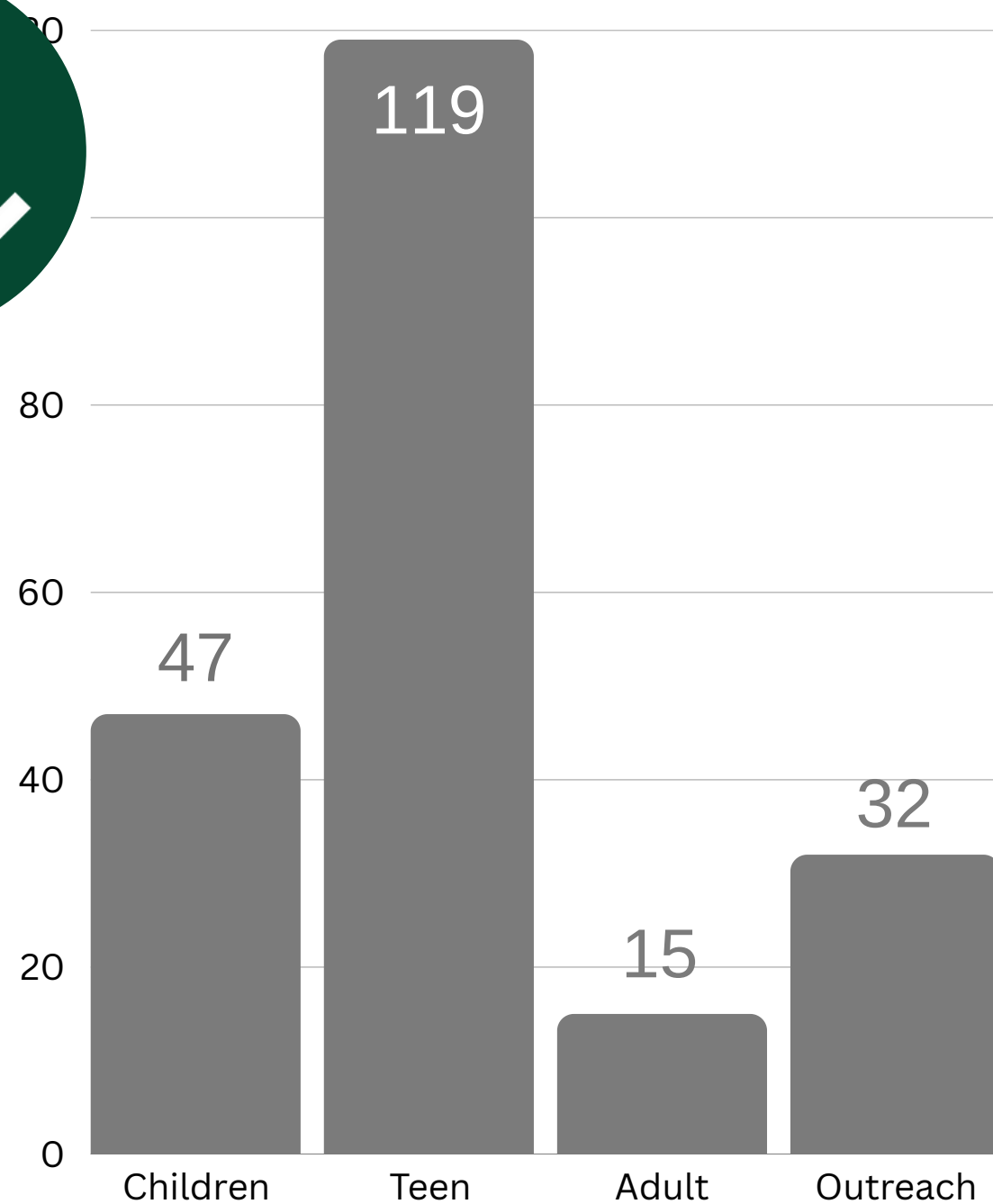

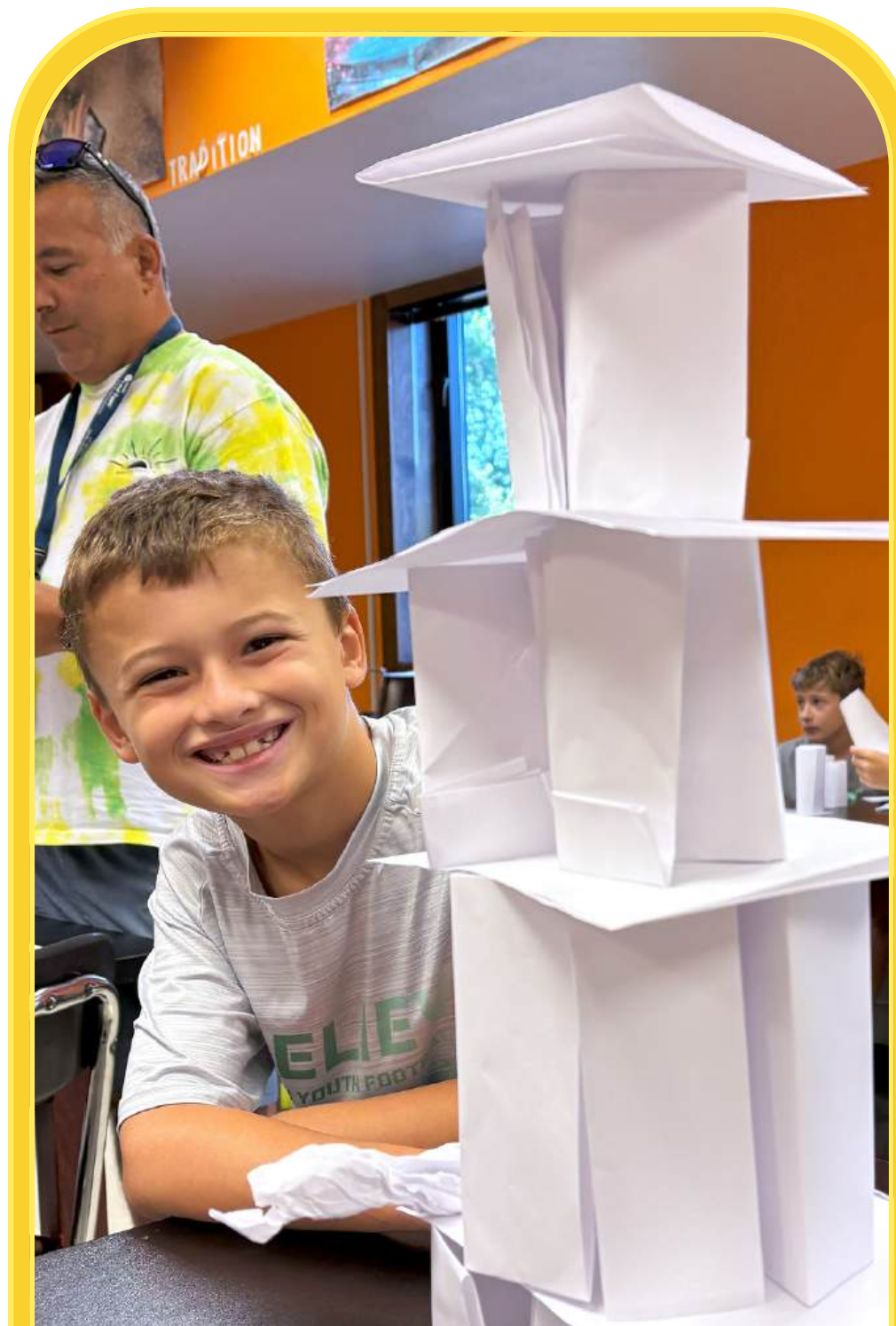
