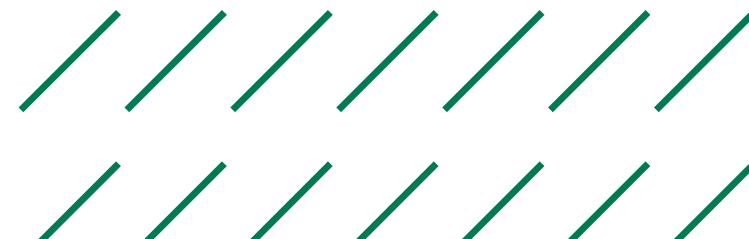
- Submitted 2025 Annual Report PA Public Library Data Survey to the Office of Commonwealth Libraries (OCL).

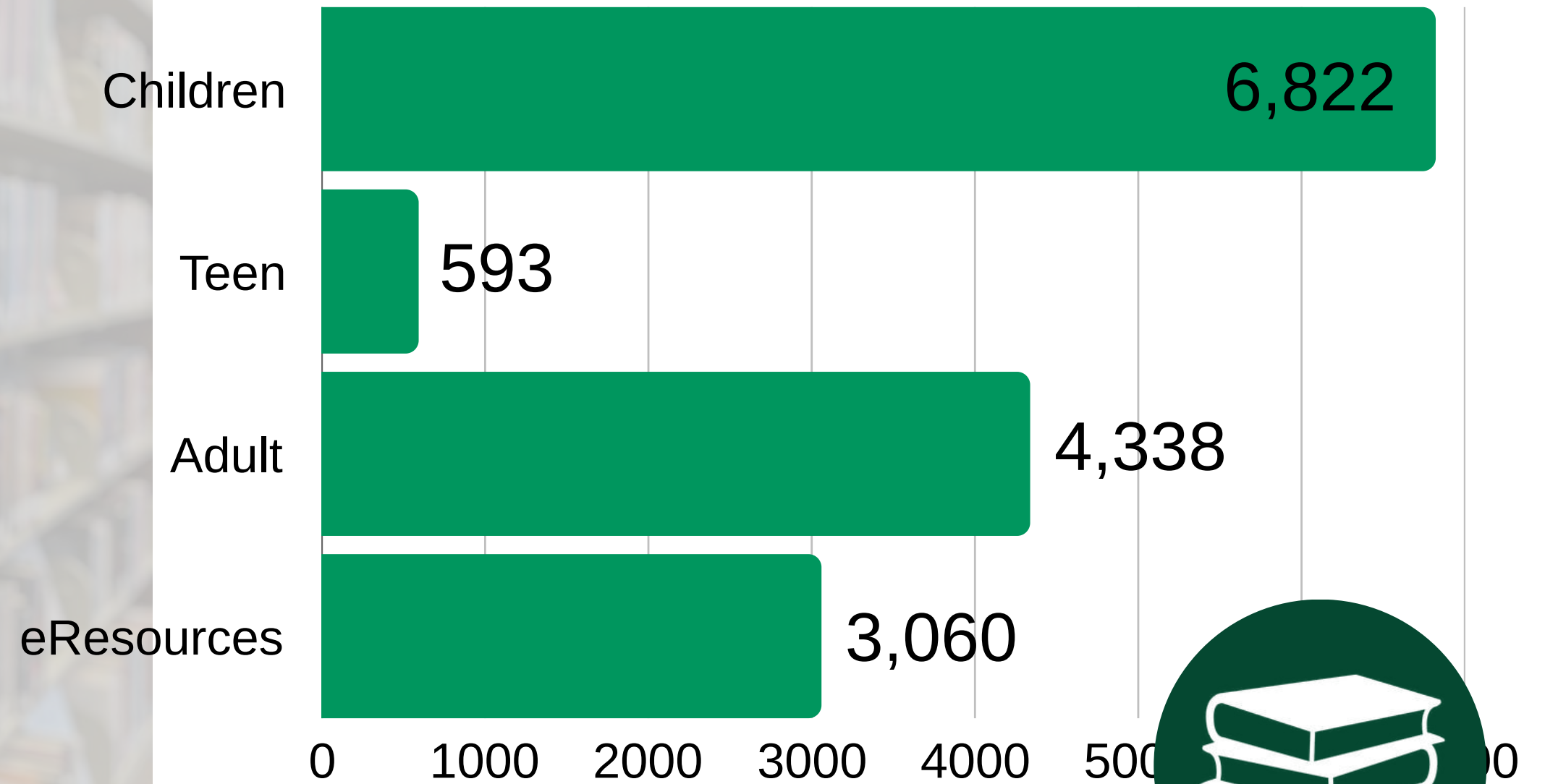

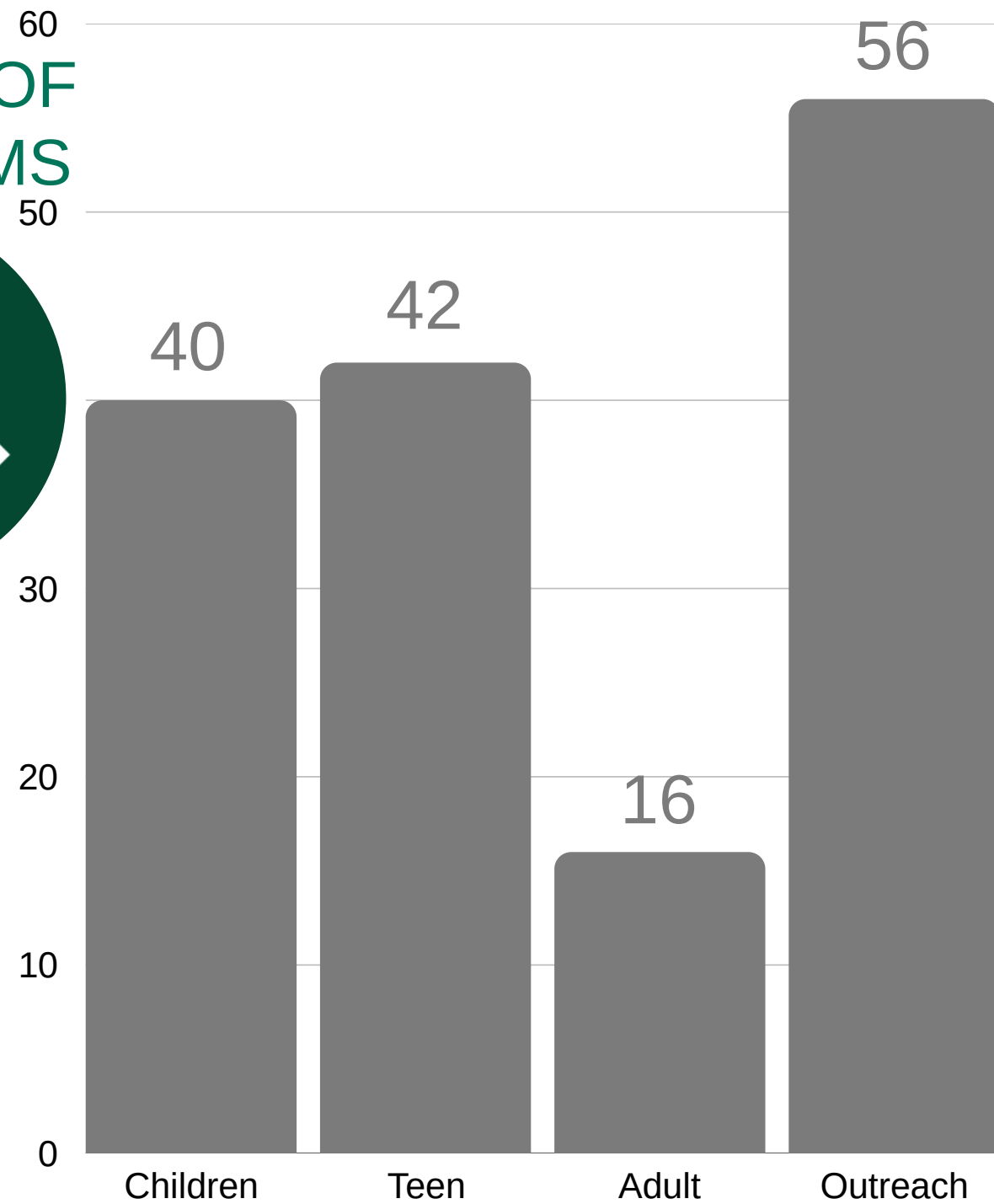

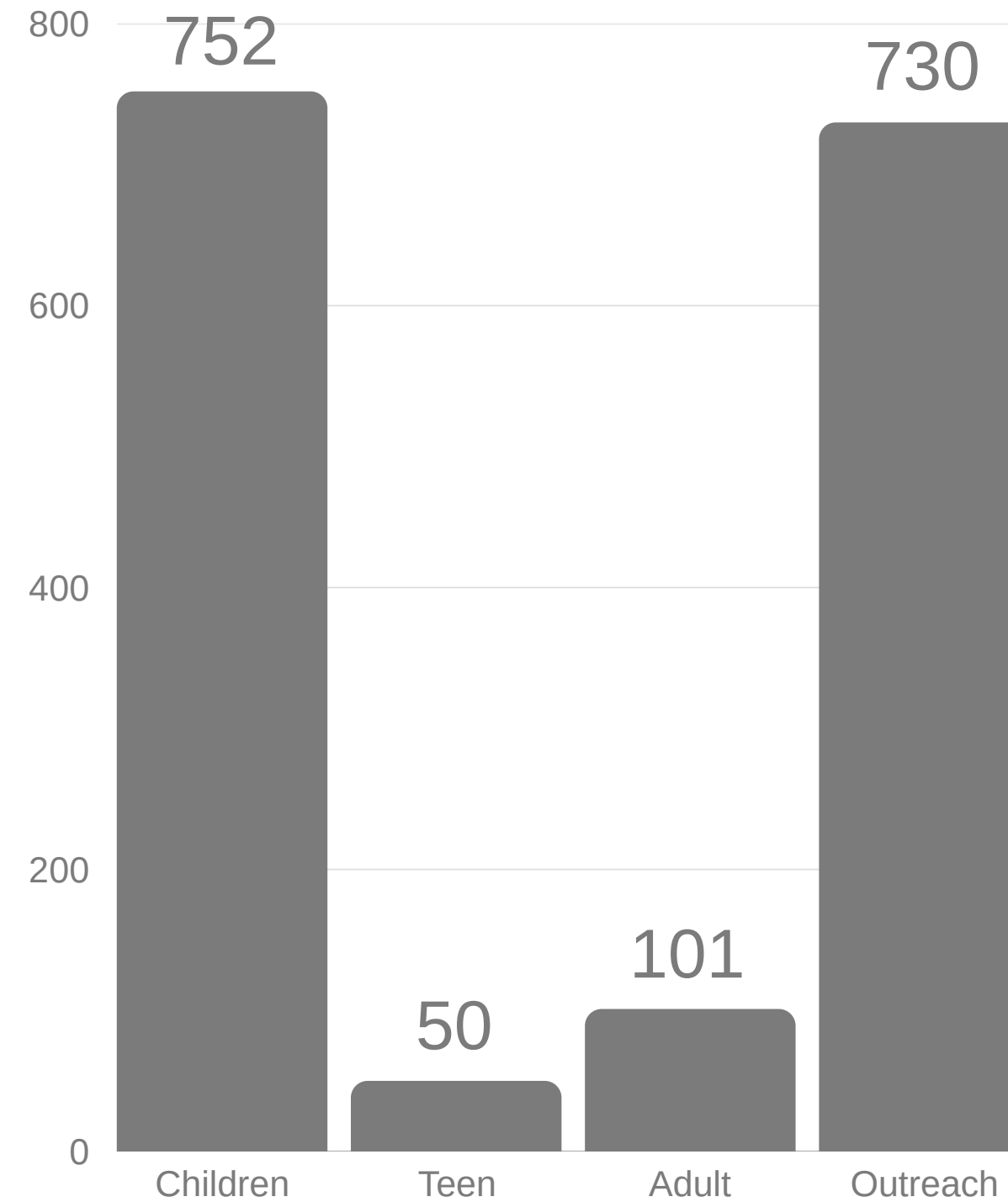

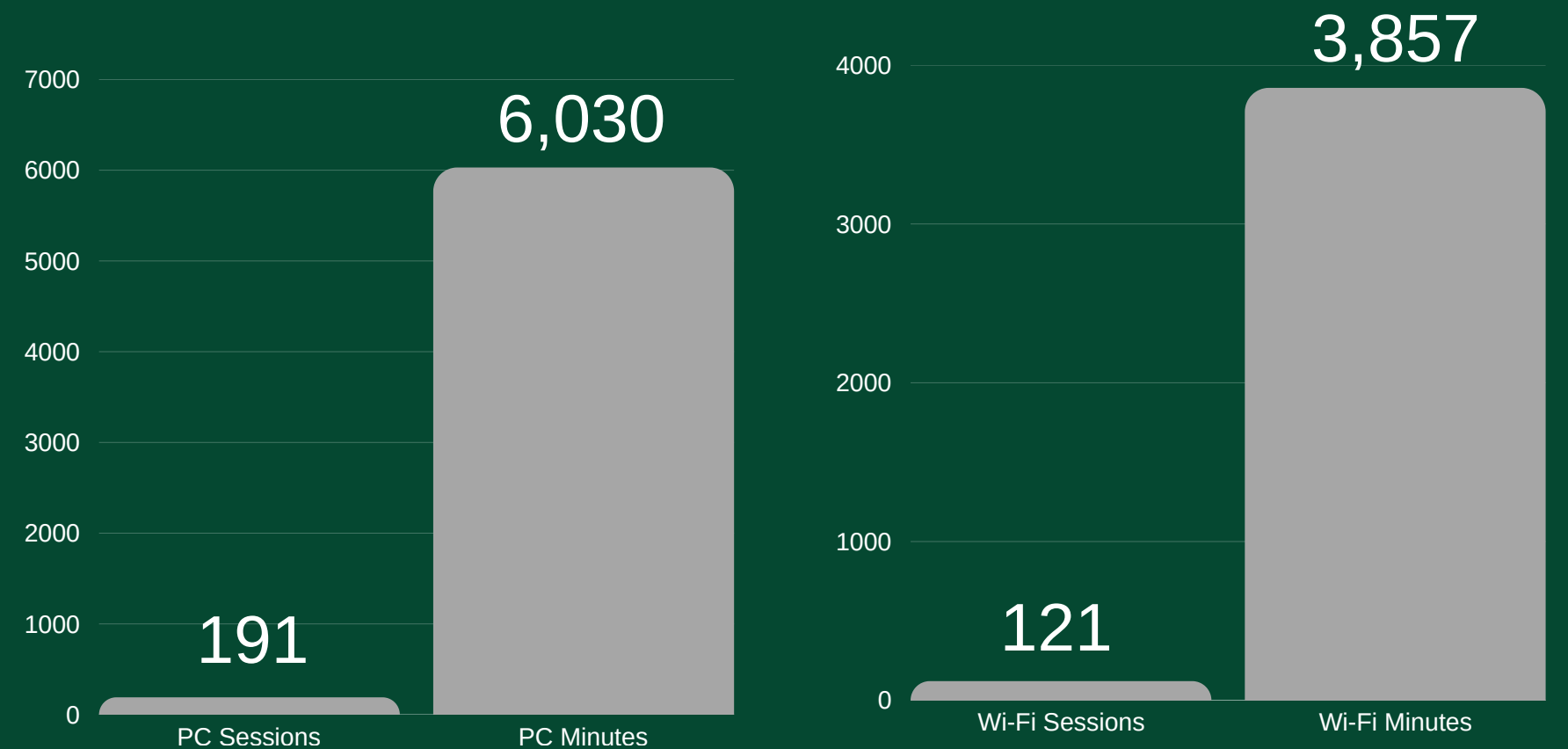
