

March Meeting Updates

- ▶ Discussed a higher number of WM issues with upper management. Over the past few weeks, they have had some staffing challenges along with truck breakdowns, and they assured me they were working through the issues, and we should see an improvement over the next few weeks.
- ▶ Reviewed the top 15 taxpayers in the Township for any appeals still in process, and no outstanding assessment appeals are currently before the BPAAR
- ▶ Worked with our solicitor on some conservatorship issues with Jordan for outstanding taxes on a property.
- ▶ Provided some additional information to CFA concerning the LSA grant for 515 Millers Run Road and requested an extension. New documents were sent over and completed for the process to finalize the extension.
- ▶ Sent out statements for various escrow accounts and followed up on outstanding balances.
- ▶ Attended the SFFAC meeting and provided updates on the process of filling the role of Fire Services Coordinator, along with MOUs. Participated in interviews for the Fire Services Coordinator. Tonight, on the agenda, we will officially hire that candidate.
- ▶ Looked into traffic signal issues near Hickory Grade Road and the 79 corridor. At this point, signals do seem to be working as designed, but vehicles are pulling into intersections and blocking traffic, which is causing additional traffic issues.
- ▶ Reviewed LERTA data with our Auditors while they were in the office last week. At this point, they have no concerns or issues.
- ▶ Worked with our electrical supplier on getting switched back to our original service company since we were switched to another company, which was going to charge us a much higher rate than what we are currently paying.
