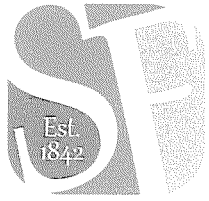

- Officers have begun their annual In-Service mandatory training for 2018. This training will continue through March.
- Phase 3 of the camera system is currently being implemented by Secure Technical Solutions, Inc. - Phase 3 locations will be: SR 50 & Miller's Run Rd (Limestone), Washington Pike at Twin Ponds Ln, the intersection of SR 50 and Parks Rd, the back parking lot at Fairview Park (new lot) and the intersection of Washington Pike at Boyce Rd. When this phase is completed, there will be a total of 44 surveillance cameras throughout the township.
- Sgt. Mike Wesolek and Ellie have responded to two requests from outside agencies in February requesting assistance in tracking lost individuals. One was in West Mifflin and one was a request from the Allegheny County Police. Both individuals were found without incident.

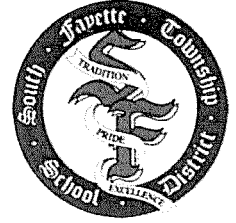
