The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – PROPOSAL FOR: GREEN LIGHT-GO ADAPTIVE SIGNAL UPGRADES

This project involves upgrades to the signalized intersection of Washington Pike (S.R. 3003) and Bursca Drive. The upgrades include the installation of new traffic signal equipment including a traffic signal controller and an adaptive traffic signal system (video). All associated traffic control and restoration is also included, complete in place.

ARTICLE 3 – TIME OF COMPLETION

Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially complete within sixty (60) calendar days after the receipt of the signal equipment and will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions within sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of the signal equipment or liquidated damages in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per calendar day will be charged. As actual damages for any delay in completion are impossible to compute and ascertain with certainty as a basis of recovery by South Fayette Township of actual damages, the Contractor and its Surety shall be liable to South Fayette Township the sum of \$500.00 as fixed and agreed for each business day of delay until the Work is complete and accepted. Such liquidated damages are intended to represent actual damages and are not intended as a penalty. Contractor shall pay to Owner without limiting Owner's right to terminate this Agreement for default as provided elsewhere herein.

Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the Contract Times.

Upon approval from the Township, the Contractor shall submit all required submittals for approval. Once approved, all materials shall be ordered immediately, during this time the Contractor/Owner can execute the contract documents; however, the materials shall be ordered as soon as approval of submittals is granted.



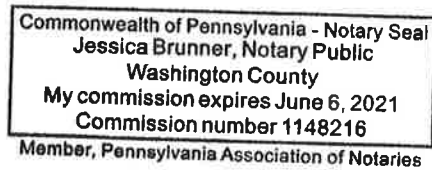
