- SFPD partnered with Collier Township, Bridgeville, Scott Township and Heidelberg police departments to collect non-perishable food items for the Bridgeville Area Food Bank from March 4 thru April 2. Thanks to all who donated!
- We have moved into the final phase of the hiring process to bring on an additional two officers. Both candidates have completed their background checks, polygraphs, medical and physiological exams. With the board's approval, both would start on April 22nd.
- All three new 2019 police vehicles are outfitted and are in service. (The two old ones have been re-assigned to the township zoning department for use.)
- On Monday March 18th the department at the request of the school district, conducted a sweep of the high school and middle school using other agencies K-9 units to assist with locker drug searches. No incidents were recorded.
- Congratulations to Sergeant Jeff Sgro and Officer Mike Zurcher for their 20 years' service to South Fayette Township.
- Sgt Leininger and Officer Jeffrey conducted a 4 hour C.R.A.S.E. training class for approximately 50 Kinder-Care employees and staff on 3/16/19.

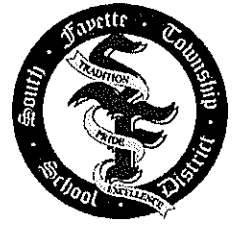
