

- All officers have been trained in the 40 mm Less Lethal launcher, BIP (Blount Impact Projectile) device and pepper ball launcher system in April, both are now in operation. Both devices will give officers an additional option in our use of force continuum.
- Alex Korkus and Rebekah Schultz began their law enforcement careers in South Fayette Township on April 22nd and will be introduced to the board at the May 8th meeting.
- The department purchased (19) Kenwood portable radios for all officers. These new portables are compatible with the radios purchased recently by the school district and will allow direct communication with school personnel in emergency situations.
