Public Works Operations

Full-time DPW employees began 'normal' schedule on June 1

Continue safe practices, including:

- One per truck - Mask required if more than 1
- Backpack sanitizers enable daily sanitizing of break room, vehicles and other spaces
- All workers have been supplied with masks and gloves

Reduced Summer Help Program began June 8. Four seasonal employees will help parks and public restrooms open on June 15

- One "Summer Aide" began seasonal employment on May 18

Public events in the parks will be cancelled
(with possible exception of Movies in the Park with social distancing and audience limits)

Parks

Pavilion rentals to be limited to 50% capacity (125 at Rotary Pavilion)

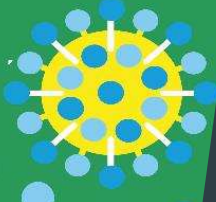
Additional signage installed with distancing guidelines and hand washing reminders

Parks - Cleaning Protocols

Two seasonal employees will be assigned to park cleaning duties

- Spray-clean playground surfaces twice daily
- Spray-clean public restrooms twice daily
- Other park maintenance duties as needed

Public Works overtime detail for weekend cleaning/sanitizing

- Prior to each pavilion rental

Athletic Fields



Beginning June 15 all athletic fields will be open to TOWNSHIP SPORTS ASSOCIATIONS ONLY (SFAA). No field rental/use by outside groups.



Township associations must submit an operational plan detailing their safety modifications

Mask Policy
Use of Dugouts and Bleachers
Sanitizing of Equipment
