1. **CALL TO ORDER** at 6:02PM by Jason Mount via Zoom.

3. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

4. **PERSONS REQUESTING TIME & CORRESPONDENCE**

5. **OLD/UNFINISHED BUSINESS**
 - A. **Community Center Layout** –Still in the design phase. Had to cut some square footage down due to cost.
 - B. **Fairview Phase I** – is in progress. The new entrance at Hastings and Mayview Roads intersection won't open until this summer. Change order to BOC due to remediation of slope issues.
 - C. **Lights on Fairview Field B** – lights will be installed on Field B. Need to upgrade the electrical system first.
6. **NEW BUSINESS**
 - A. **Thank You Notes** – Paula would like the PR Board members to write and sign thank you letters to our sponsors to add a personal touch. All agreed we could do this.
7. **Director's Report**
 - A. **Dog Park Rules** – the BOC will have to take the current rules out of the Parks and Recreation ordinances. Paula will be working on the new rules. Once she has a rough draft, she will share it with the PR Board for review and approval to forward on to the solicitor and BOC.
 - B. **Bunny Hop** -April 14 will be a drive through event for Easter. 450 cars are registered.
 - C. **Summer Camp** Staff interviews went well and will be hiring the staff this week.
 - D. **Earth Week** – residents can get bags, gloves, vests, etc at the township office to clean up their neighborhoods. A dumpster will be available at the Municipal Building. Staff will be doing clean up on some of the major roads and intersections.
 - E. **Fairview Multipurpose Fields**- some are closed due to bare spots. Trying to find a place for lacrosse to play. Working on this with the school district. Paula is trying to create a better relationship with the school district.
 - F. **Baseball Fields** – some will be serviced by a company to get new dirt (Morgan A & E, and Fairview A & B). Public works will do the other fields in-house.

G. Morgan Park Grants – received county grants to upgrade the concession stand, restrooms, and parking at Morgan Park. This is in the design phase. Hoping to go out to bid this summer and start work in the fall.

H. Youth Sports Information – need to work with the township to create a database of local youth sports so when residents call either the township or the school, they can receive accurate information about who to contact to sign their kids up for youth sports and activities. Paula has the information for sports that use township facilities, but not for other sports like volleyball, wrestling, basketball, etc.
