A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RECEIVING AND ACCEPTING A FEASIBILITY REPORT FOR THE SOUTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a directive from the South Fayette Township Board of Commissioners, the Township undertook, with the assistance of a professional planner, a South Fayette Township Community Center Feasibility Study; and

WHEREAS, this project was financed in part by a grant from the Community Conservation Partnership Program, Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation fund, under the administration of the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Recreation and Conservation and;

WHEREAS, the study was conducted following the protocol and procedures of the Community Conservation Partnership Program, Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation fund, under the administration of the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Recreation and Conservation; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study committee submitted its final report on May 17, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the report provides information regarding whether a community center is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; what types of amenities should be included in a facility, size of proposed facilities and types of programming that should be provided in the community center.

WHEREAS, this report will serve as a tool and resources for this and future Board to make public policy and decision regarding the development of a community center.


