**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY TASK FORCE TO RESEARCH,
MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS AND ADDRESS TRAFFIC ISSUES IN THE STATE
ROUTE 50 AND WASHINGTON PIKE CORRIDORS**

WHEREAS, the Township of South Fayette is experiencing rapid growth in both residential and commercial areas; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Fayette desires to provide appropriate levels of transportation levels of service to its citizens so as to adequately protect their health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Fayette would like to coordinate the desired traffic improvements with neighboring municipalities and major developers to develop a unified strategy and voice for working with Penn DOT and other transportation funding organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The State Route 50/Washington Pike Corridor Traffic Improvements Task Force is hereby created and shall consist of the following members:

Ray Caruso, Township Traffic Engineer

Neighboring Municipalities: Bridgeville
Upper Saint Clair
Collier

Private Developers: Newbury Market
Crossings of South Fayette

Other: As the Township and other members deem as necessary.


2. All of the above named members have direct affiliation with one of the entities listed above or as agreed to by the overall membership.

4. The task force shall not only serve in an advisory capacity but shall also communicate with the appropriate transportation organizations and coordinate specific traffic improvement recommendations and funding requests with Penn DOT.
