

## Boyce/Mayview Roads Regular Station & Pipeline Replacement Project

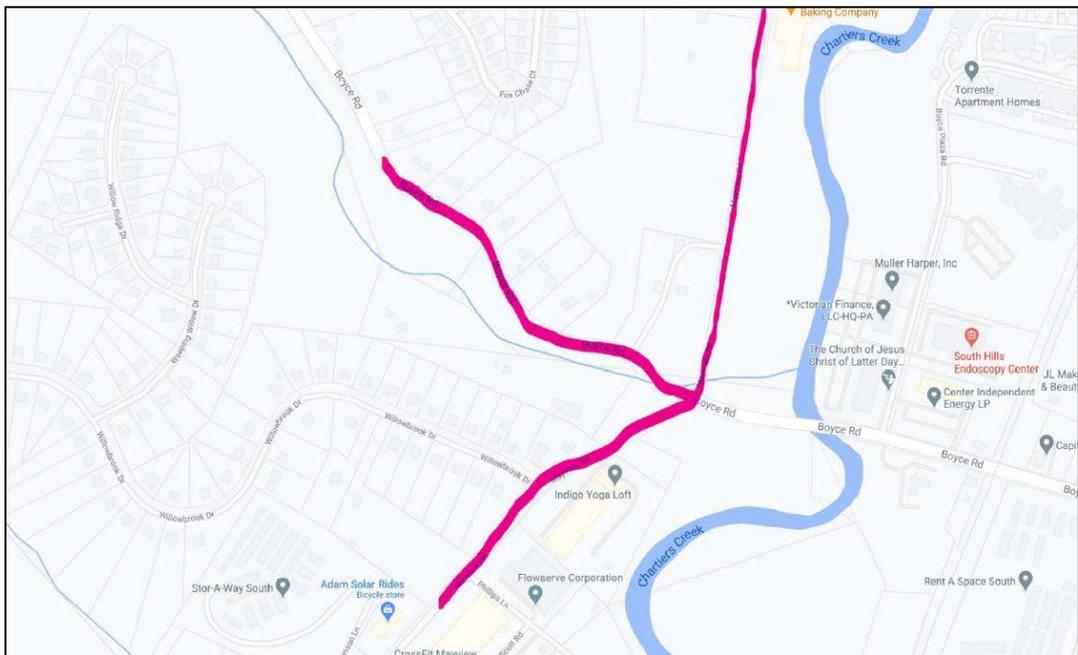
**Start Date:** Mid November **Expected Completion:** Spring 2021

### Initial Work Schedule:

Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting

Motorists can expect lane restrictions throughout the project, but local traffic and emergency responders will have access to the affected streets.

## WHAT CUSTOMERS CAN EXPECT

Columbia Gas will be relocating a regulator station along Mayview Road and replacing approximately 5,600 feet of natural gas pipeline along sections of Boyce and Mayview roads in advance of an upcoming PennDOT stream relocation and road realignment project.

Work on Boyce and Mayview roads will occur Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., weather permitting. Temporary road restrictions will be in place during working hours, and traffic control measures, including flaggers and local police, will be used to maintain the safe flow of traffic in the area.

We regret any inconvenience this may cause and will make every effort to limit traffic restrictions or delays.

After the new pipeline has been installed, approximately 20 customers' gas service will be temporarily interrupted for several hours as service is transferred from the old gas pipeline to the upgraded pipeline. A Columbia Gas employee or contractor will notify customers in person or with a door hanger at least three days before gas service is interrupted. If we can't reach a customer in person, a tag will be left on their door with information on how to schedule a time when we can switch their service.

After the customer's service is transferred to the new pipe, a Columbia Gas representative or contractor will need access to the home or business to restore gas service and perform safety checks on any gas appliances and house piping inside and outside the premises.

## HELP KEEP YOU AND OUR CREWS SAFE

During this unprecedented time, we have taken proactive steps to implement additional safety precautions as we perform our work.

As we are working in the neighborhood we will be maintaining social distancing, and ask that everyone help keep our teams safe and also maintain six feet of distance from our crews.

Our employees are following Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines including:

- Washing their hands with soap and water or using hand sanitizer
- Practicing social distancing where practicable (maintaining six feet from others)
- Wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) appropriate for the situation and the job, such as gloves, face coverings, etc.
- Avoiding touching their face, eyes, nose or mouth, handshaking and any other physical contact
- Using disinfectant wipes on surfaces where they are working
- Minimizing time spent inside to what is needed to accomplish the task

## PROPERTY RESTORATION

Please know we will fully restore any yards, landscaping, driveways, and sidewalks to municipality standards when the project is complete.

We wish to limit the inconvenience to customers and urge them to contact us with any questions or concerns.
