**ORDINANCE NO. 11 OF 2020**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RIGHT-OF-WAY PLANS FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE ROBINSON RUN BRIDGE #3 OVER THE SOUTH BRANCH OF THE ROBINSON RUN TRAIL , SOUTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND ACCEPTING ADDITIONAL RIGHT OF WAY FOR INCORPORATION INTO MILL STREET.**

WHEREAS, the County of Allegheny has submitted to the Township plans and drawings (“Right of Way Plans”) authorizing the acquisition of property by Allegheny County in locations that abut Mill Street, a Township Road, for the replacement of the deteriorated Robinson Run Bridge #3 (“Bridge”) that is located over the south branch of the Robinson Run trail located adjacent to Mill Street, South Fayette Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania ; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Plans, the County will be acquiring the property for construction access and maintenance access to the bridge thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the County of Allegheny, in accordance with applicable regulations, is required to and desires to turn over the property acquired by them to the Township for incorporated into Mill Street which abuts the bridge.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FAYETTE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated herein by reference thereto.
2. The Chairman of the Township of the Board of Commissions is hereby authorized to execute Right-of-Way Plans presented to the Township by Allegheny County.
3. The Township, upon completion of the replacement of the Bridge agrees to accept the Right-of-Way acquired by the County and depicted on the Right-of-Way Plans for incorporation into the Mill Street, a Township Road.
4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeals shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other aspects, this ordinance shall be cumulative of the other ordinance regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.
5. If any section or provision or parts hereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any other section or provision or part thereof.
6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
